In the Haggada we read about the four different types of sons one could have, and how one should teach each of them about Yetzias Mitzrayim, the Exodos from Egypt. The wording used in listing the four sons seems redundant: **“The Torah speaks about 4 sons: one who is wise, one who is wicked, one who is simple, and one who does not know how to ask.”** Why does the Ba'al Haggada use the word “Echad - one” to modify each son? Why not just list them – wise, wicked, etc? We learn an important lesson in Chinuch from this

wording. Each of our children should seem in our eyes as the only child. Our thoughts have to be focused on raising each individual child, with his unique qualities, in his own way. Part of BINA’s mission is to recognize each student’s strengths and challenges and to work with each as an individual to develop her potential. With Hashem’s help, together we will succeed in inspiring each girl to be independent and motivated in her service of Hashem. Have a Chag Kasher V’sameach!
