A Message From Our Menacheles- Mrs. Aviva Harpaz



When the Jewish People traveled in the dessert for the 40 years between the Exodus from Mitzrayim and entering Eretz Yisrael, there was a specific configuration in which each of the tribes traveled. The first group, leading the way, was comprised of the Shevatim of Yehuda, Yisachar, and Zevulun, the tribes that are known as the Lomdei and Machzikei Torah – the Torah learners and supporters. The Kli Yakar points out that these are the ones that would travel first, because Torah is the source of the Jewish People’s strength. The numerical value of the initials of these tribes is 27, the same as the number of letters in the Aleph Bais, including the final letters. It’s in the merit of the Torah, which is comprised of these 27 letters, that these tribes would lead the Jewish people successfully. As we head into Shavuos and renew our connection and commitment to Torah, we are tapping into the true strength of our nation. 
